#### ENQUIRIES

Of all the tables produced from the 1981 Survey, only a limited number have been selected for publication in this report. The tabulation programme of the 1981 Survey comprised many other tables cross-classified by industry and various economic attributes. Detailed statistics showing the breakdown of various component items in principal statistics are also available. ## I. Introduction

### 1. Background

From 1982 to 1983, the Census and Statistics Department conducted an Annual Survey of Industrial Production covering the activities of mining and quarrying, manufacturing, and the supply of electricity, gas and water in respect of 1981. Similar surveys were conducted for the years 1973, 1976, 1977, 1978, 1979 and 1980. The coverage of all these enquiries conformed with Major Divisions 2, 3 and 4 of the United Nations International Standard Industrial Classification of All Economic Activities (I.S.I.C.). For 1974 and 1975, the surveys covered the textiles and clothing industries only.

### 2. Objectives of the Survey

The objectives of the 1981 Survey were to collect statistics required for assessing industrial performance, structural changes and intra- and inter-industry comparisons; to estimate value added for updating the contribution of the industrial sector to Hong Kong's Gross Domestic Product; and to collect commodity details of industrial production so as to depict changes in output level and product mix.

### 3. Legislation

The 1981 Survey was conducted under the authority of the Census and Statistics (Annual Survey of Industrial Production) Order 1981, which was approved by the Governor in Council under the Census and Statistics Ordinance (Chapter 316) and published in the Government Gazette as Legal Notice No. 18/81 on 30th January 1981. The said Ordinance provides for the collection of specified data from respondents, and obliges the Department to preserve the confidentiality of information of individual establishments.

### 4. Survey coverage

The frame for conducting the Survey was a comprehensive register of all manufacturing establishments which was maintained and kept up-to-date by the Department using information from the Business Registration Office of the Inland Revenue Department and the factory registration system of the Labour Department. The list of mining and quarrying establishments was furnished by the Mines Division of the Labour Department while that of welfare institution workshops, which included those run by the Social Welfare Department and some non-profit institutions, was furnished by the Social Welfare Department. The list of Government industrial undertakings, consisting of 2 quarries, 1 printing house, 17 prison workshops, 2 abattoirs and 1 water works establishment, and that of electricity and gas companies were compiled by the Census and Statistics Department.

### 5. Sample design

The sampling frame for the Survey was stratified by industries and by employment size ranges. All manufacturing establishments engaging 100 or more persons were enumerated fully. For those establishments

engaging fewer than 100 persons, the sample size and structure for each of the 149 constituent industries were determined by the method of optimum allocation according to a desired level of precision for the value added estimate in each industry. Individual sampling units were then drawn out by systematic selection with a random start. The total sample size for the manufacturing sector was 7 925 establishments, out of a register of 59 973 establishments.

## 6. Enumeration and data processing

The method of postal enquiry coupled with field follow-up visits was adopted for enumeration. Survey questionnaires were mailed to sampled establishments in April 1982, while visits by field officers were made between May 1982 and March 1983 by the end of which 5 927 completed returns were received. There were 1 970 deletion cases which were closures, untraceable removals, branches without separate returns, establishments outside the scope of the Survey etc. The balance of 28 cases were non-responses or partially completed returns requiring office imputations, representing 0.4% of the manufacturing establishments initially sampled. Completed questionnaires underwent thorough checking by office staff as well as data validation checks by the computer before tabulation. Dubious reported data were clarified by telephone enquiries or field verification visits.

Altogether 107 statistical tables were produced by the computer, of which only 20 more basic ones were selected for publication in this report due to limited printing space. Enquiries on the unpublished statistics may be directed to the Industrial Production Statistics Section of the Census and Statistics Department.

Notes to statistical tables

- (i) Unlike previous survey reports which placed more emphasis on the reporting establishments only, all the statistical tables in this report, except Table 20 on standard errors, relate to "all establishments" which also incorporated the economic contributions of non-reporting establishments\*\*. The economic contributions of non-reporting establishments were imputed from their employment levels as recorded in a regular employment enquiry, with due reference to the cost and production patterns displayed by reporting establishments of the same industry and employment size. Establishments operating for only part of 1981 were imputed with a lesser economic contribution than a similar one operating throughout the year. The number of non-reporting establishments, however, denotes an actual count of those factories.
- (ii) Table 20 presents the sampling errors for some of the key economic variables of "reporting" establishments. Sampling errors for "all" establishments have not been compiled.
- (iii) In order to ensure that information relating to individual establishments is not disclosed, data cells containing one or two establishments are suppressed, showing only the number of persons engaged. An additional cell with the smallest value added is also suppressed to prevent the deduction of a suppressed cell from the total.
- (iv) An asterisk denotes statistics being suppressed for confidentiality reasons. The statistics are, nevertheless, included in the respective totals at some broader level of classification.
- (v) N.E.C. means not elsewhere classified.
- (vi) Individual entries of a column may not add up exactly to the respective totals due to rounding.

\*\* "Non-reporting establishments" refer to those establishments which operated during part or whole of the reference period but which ceased operation during the survey operation such that data could not be obtained in respect of them.

## Notes to Table 5

(1) Figures in brackets shown under the columns of 1979, 1980 and 1981 denote percentage changes of 1979 over 1978, 1980 over 1979, and 1981 over 1980, respectively.

(2) An asterisk denotes the percentage change less than 0.5%.

(3) # Prior to 1981, excise duties were included in the values of sales, gross output and value added. As from 1981 onwards, excise duties for tobacco and alcoholic beverages are excluded so as to derive value added at factor cost. If excise duties were included, the figures for the "broad" industry group "Food, beverages and tobacco" in 1981 would have become \$5 236 789, \$5 250 589, and \$1 473 687 respectively for sales and work done, gross output and national accounts value added. The corresponding changes over 1980 would have been 18%, 18% and 17% respectively.

## Note to Table 12

If excise duties were included in gross output and value added in 1981, the ratios of various statistics to gross output for the industry group "Beverages" would have become 49% for consumption of materials, supplies and industrial services, 16% for compensation of employees, 18% for miscellaneous operating expenses, 17% for gross surplus, and 35% for national accounts value added. The corresponding ratios for "Tobacco" would have been 42%, 5%, 15%, 38% and 44% respectively.

For the purpose of analysis by industry, establishments in the 1981 Survey were classified into 149 industries. The industries were aggregated into 23 industry groups and further into 10 "broad" industry groups.

The descriptions and codes for the "broad" industry groups and industry groups are given below, whilst those for the 149 industries can be found in Table 18 of this report.
