2. Operating Characteristics of the ICT Sector

- In 2024, there were some 17 000 companies in the ICT sector with around 119 400 persons engaged, representing 3.2% of the total number of employed persons in Hong Kong.

- In 2024, the value added of the ICT sector amounted to \$183.0 billion, representing 5.9% of the GDP at basic prices and increased by 9.0% compared with 2023.

- In 2024, industries engaged in the distribution of ICT goods and those in the provision of ICT services accounted for 48.1% and 51.8% of the number of companies in the ICT sector respectively. Their corresponding shares in terms of employment were 36.3% and 63.3%, whereas those in terms of value added stood at 51.6% and 48.4%.

There were also 187 telecommunications licensees authorised to provide external fixed telecommunications services and 356 telecommunications licensees authorised to provide Internet access services in Hong Kong.

3. Trade in ICT Goods and Services

ICT Goods

- In 2025, imports of ICT goods amounted to \$3,650.9 billion, accounting for 64.2% of the overall value of imports of all goods.
- In the same year, the value of total exports of ICT goods reached \$3,607.4 billion, representing 68.8% of the overall value of total exports of all goods.

- In 2025, imports of communication equipment amounted to \$615.0 billion, Chinese Mainland (the Mainland) was the major supplier, accounting for 51.0% of the total.
- In the same year, the value of total exports of communication equipment was \$545.5 billion. The United States of America (USA), the Mainland and the United Arab Emirates were the three largest destinations, accounting for 22.2%, 14.8% and 10.3% respectively of the total.

ICT Services and Digitally-deliverable Services

- In 2024, the value of imports of ICT services amounted to \$21.5 billion, accounting for 3.1% of the overall value of imports of all services.
- In the same year, the value of exports of ICT services was \$31.1 billion, representing 3.7% of the overall value of exports of all services.
- In 2024, the value of imports of digitally-deliverable services amounted to \$225.7 billion, accounting for 32.3% of the overall value of imports of all services.
- In the same year, the value of exports of digitally-deliverable services was \$387.6 billion, representing 46.4% of the overall value of exports of all services.

4. Access to and Use of ICT

Access to ICT

- In 2025, there were 40.8 fixed telephone lines per 100 population. On the other hand, the number of public mobile subscriptions reached 34.33 million and the number of public mobile subscriptions per 100 population was 457.1.
- In 2025, there were 40.8 fixed broadband Internet access lines per 100 population.
- With the advances in technology, the mobile broadband services have proliferated. The mobile broadband subscriptions per 100 population increased from 309.3 in 2020 to 457.0 in 2025, up by an average of 8.1% per annum.

Chart 4.1-A : Fixed broadband Internet subscriptions / registered access lines per 100 population

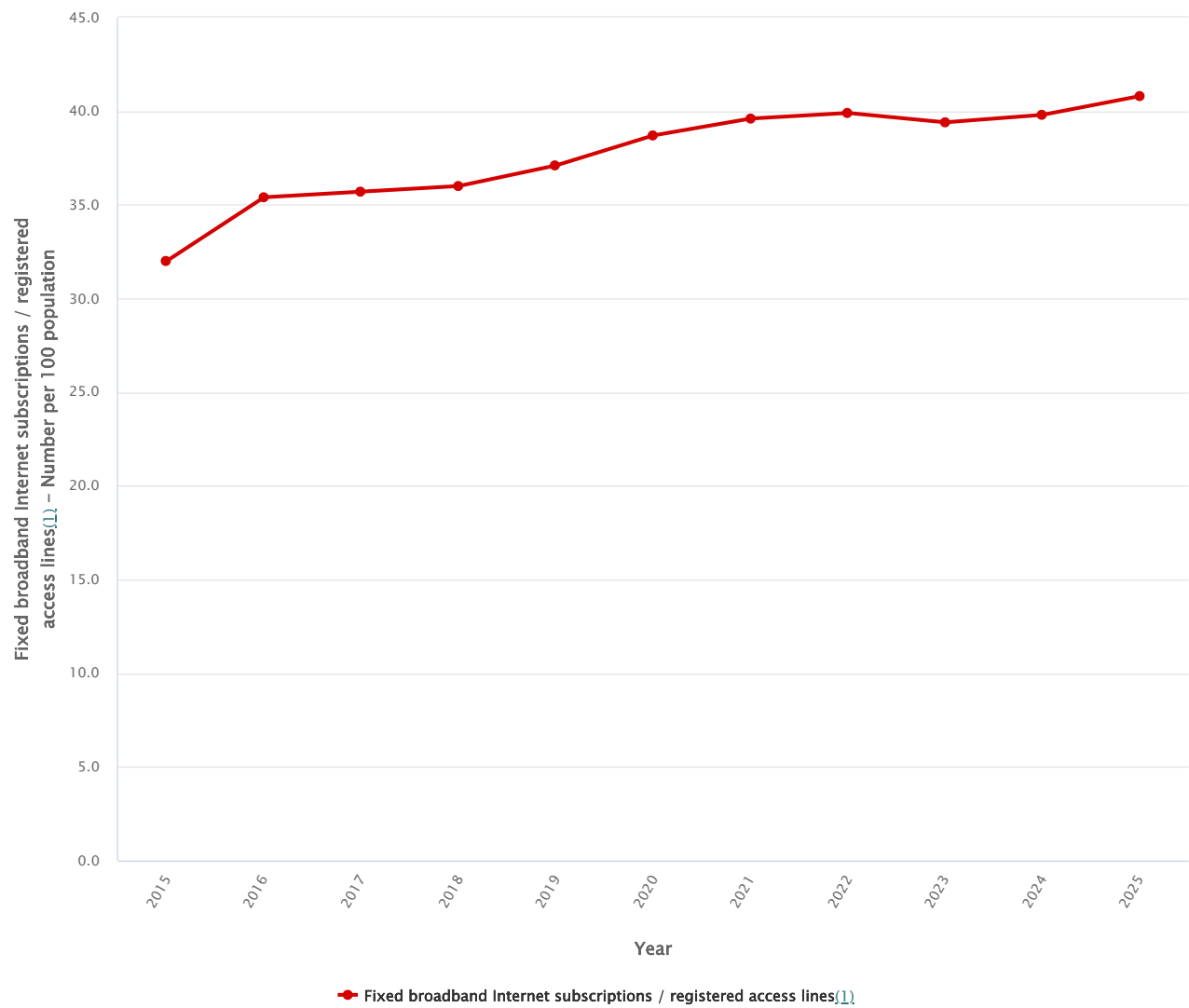


Chart 4.1-B : Mobile broadband subscriptions per 100 population

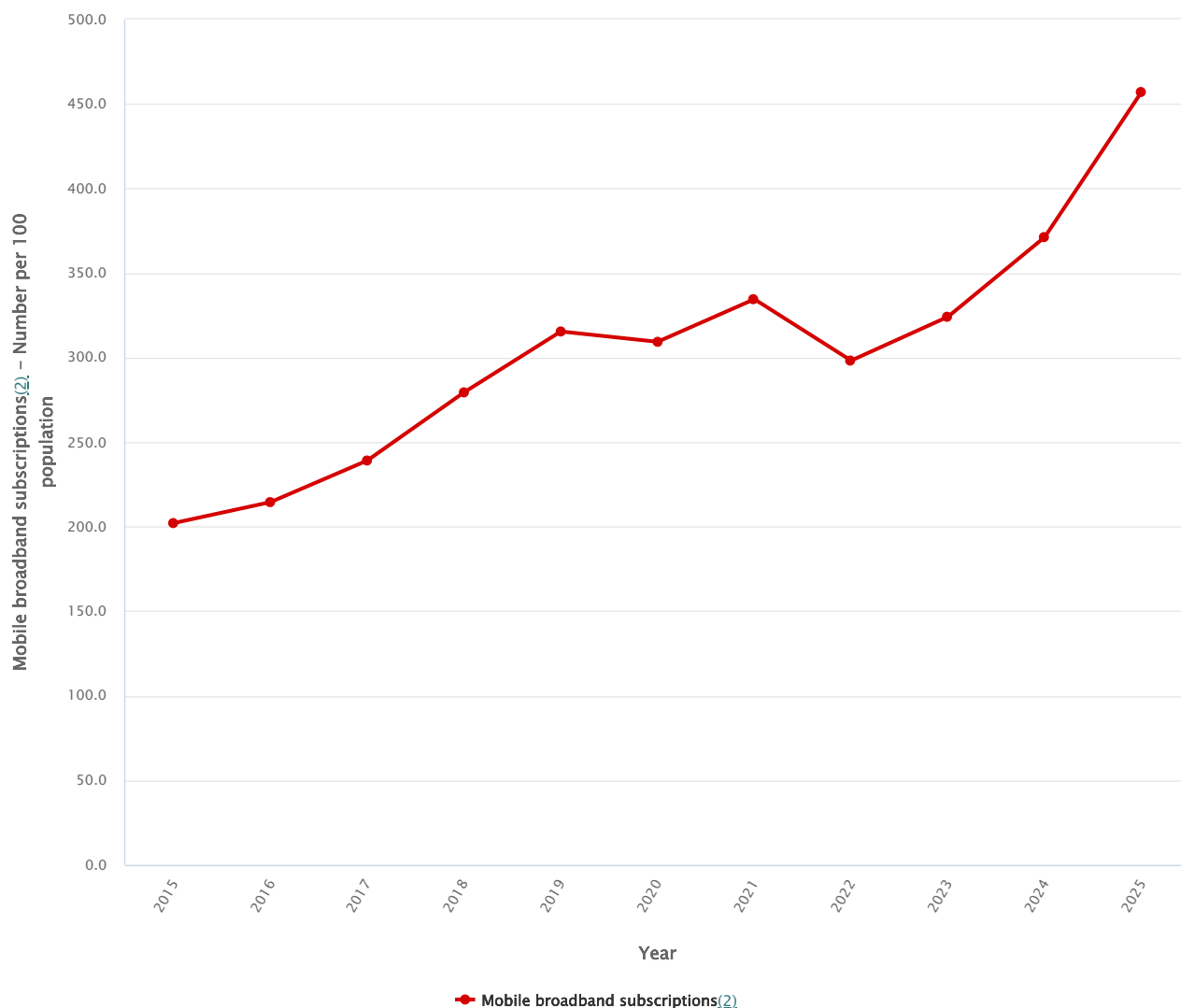

Use of ICT by Businesses

- In 2025, 92.5% of the companies had used computers and 98.7% of the companies had used smartphone for business purpose. Besides, the proportion of companies using the Internet was relatively higher, at 99.3%. As regards companies with a web presence, the proportion was relatively low (57.2%).
- Among all the companies using the Internet, 92.5% used fixed broadband to connect to the Internet. The corresponding figures for 4G and 5G mobile broadband were 51.5% and 77.3% respectively.

5. Human Resources and Education in Information Technology (IT)

Manpower Structure in the IT Field: The Manpower Survey of the Innovation and Technology Sector (formerly known as the Manpower Survey of the Information Technology Sector) is conducted by the Vocational Training Council. Starting from 2018, this survey is conducted once every four years.

- The total number of IT employees was 112 425 in 2022, constituting 3.0% of the labour force in Hong Kong and increasing by 17.4% as compared with 95 780 in 2018.
- Analysed by job category, among the 112 425 IT employees in 2022, 46 644 (41.5%) were engaged in software development; 31 117 (27.7%) in infrastructure and operations support; and 10 772 (9.6%) in IT sales and marketing.
- IT security, software development and data management recorded significant percentage growth in number of IT employees between 2018 and 2022 at 41.9%, 27.9% and 26.4% respectively.
